Lesson One: The High Price of Doing Things Right

The lesson will focus on the high price of excellence. There is a price to pay for doing things right for God. We will explore the cost.

Question: Have you considered the cost?

Lesson Two: Life at its Best

Lesson two will be centered on Philippians 1. Life at its best is a life centered on our relationship to Jesus Christ and our response to this relationship. Life at its best is a life that is IN Christ, FOR Christ, and WITH Christ.

Question: Are you living a life that is IN, FOR, and WITH Christ?

Lesson Three: Faith is the Victory

Our faith is the victory that overcomes the difficulties we encounter in life. The distrust, disbelief, doubts and worry we all wrestle with in life is overcome with our faith in God. This faith we share overcomes even death. The lesson will be based on 1 John 5:4, *"For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world, even our faith."* KJV

Our faith is also strengthened by the words of Christ in John 16:33 *"These things I have spoken to unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world."*

Question: Is your faith victorious?

Lesson Four: Blessed Assurance

As Christians, we should have a clear assurance of our salvation. We can KNOW that we are saved. We can KNOW blessed assurance. Our study will focus on this assurance. We will also look at why and how many may lack this assurance.

Question: Are you saved? Are you SURE?

Lesson Five: Dealing with the Pressure of Time

TIME! It is a necessity, but we have very little in life. We will look together at how we use our time here on earth and our priorities of our responsibility in the use of our time as Christians.

Question: Are you using your time to glorify God?
