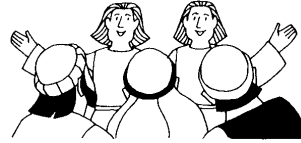

The apostles received the Holy Spirit on the Day of Pentecost.



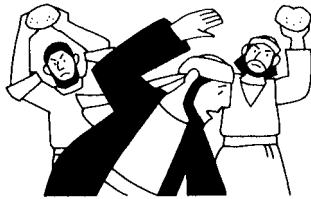
APOSTLES ON PENTECOST

Peter delivers a sermon on the Day of Pentecost and 3000 people were baptized that day.

Many signs and wonders are performed by the Apostles as a proof of the Gospel.

Deacons are appointed in the church at Jerusalem; Stephen is one of them.

Stephen is stoned to death and the disciples are scattered.

Philip converts the people in Samaria and the Ethiopian Eunuch.

Saul, a persecutor of Christians is converted in Damascus.



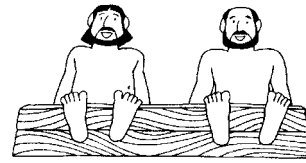
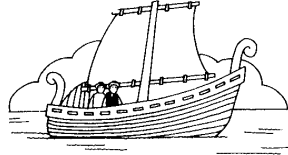
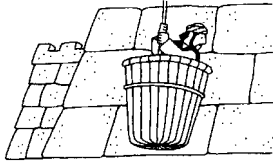
SAUL OF TARSUS
