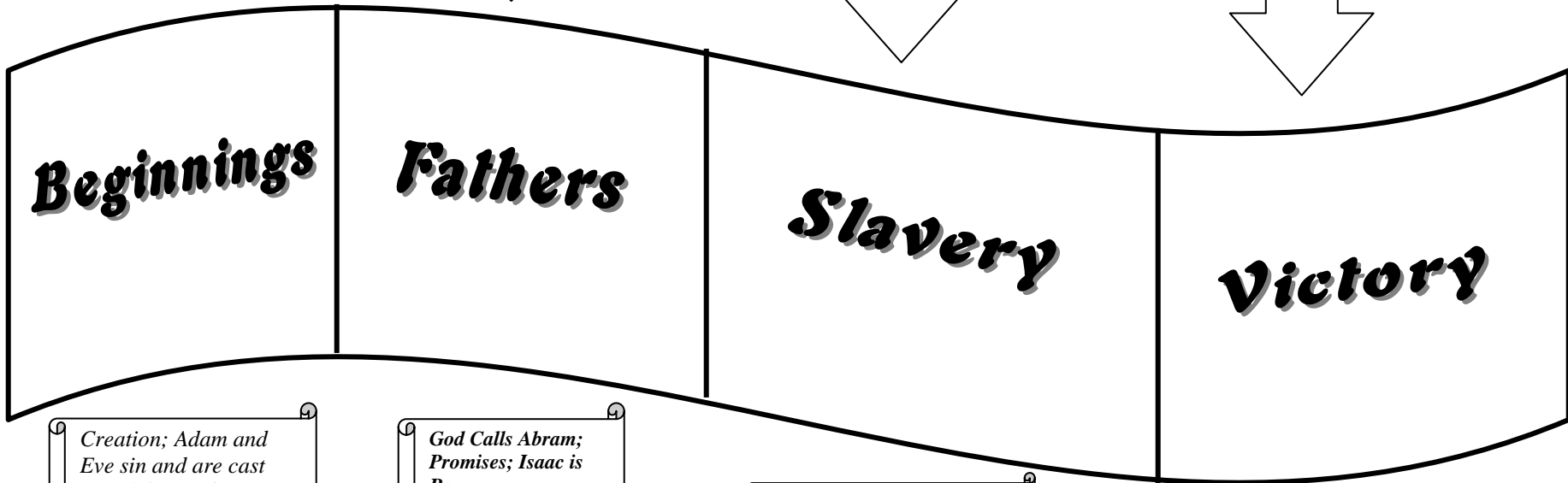

*Tabernacle built; 12 Spies report; 40 years of wandering*

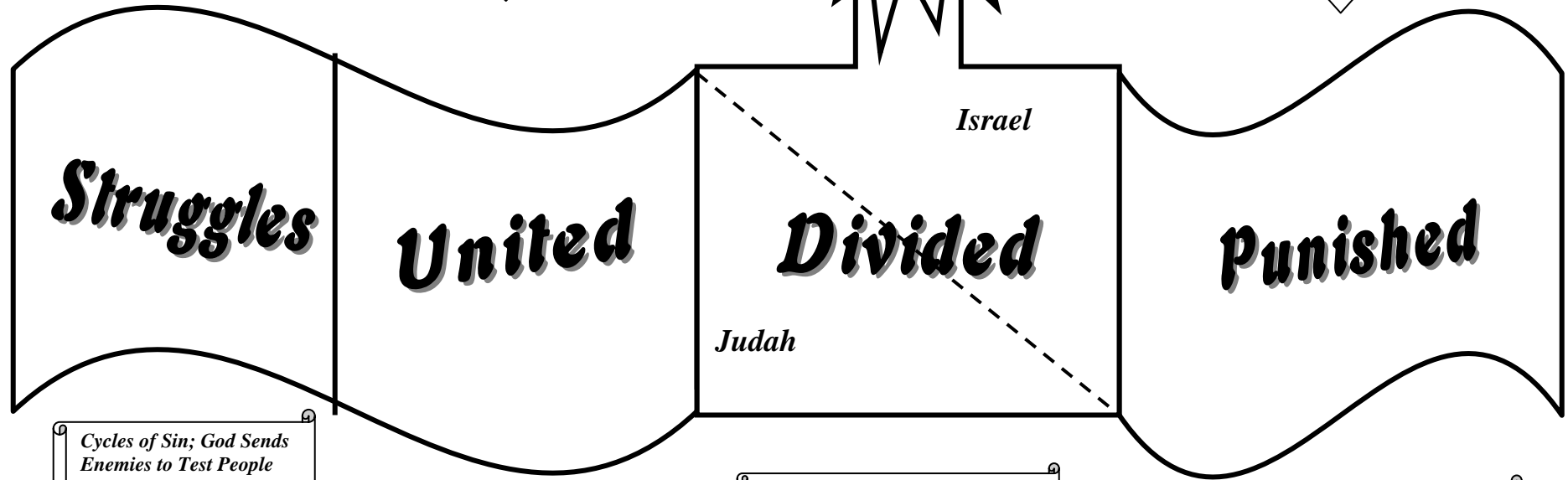

of Jerusalem*

*CHRIST: Our Promised Savior and
